

Hearing & Vision

Hearing and Vision Screenings are done in the fall (Sept, Oct, Nov) of each school year. The State of Illinois requires all schools to complete screenings and report findings every year. The grade levels that are screened in your child's school are as follows:

- Preschool/Early Childhood
- Kindergarten
- First thru Fourth Grades
- Fifth Grade
- Eighth Grade
- All special education students
- All students receiving speech services
- Parent or Teacher requests



If your child fails a hearing or vision screening, you will receive a letter explaining what measures are to be taken.

If your child has a hearing or vision loss, please be sure to notify your child's teacher. Please make sure to also indicate this information each year at registration on the Health History Forms.

Hearing & Vision Certification

Michelle Blomberg is certified by the State of Illinois to perform hearing and vision screenings. This certificate also requires re-certification every two years.
